

XANALYS® ChartViewer 2.0 Read Me

This Readme contains instructions for installing XANALYS ChartViewer, details of new features and any last-minute information.

1 XANALYS ChartViewer 2.0r2

Note ChartViewer charts do not incorporate any encryption. This means that if you are sending ChartViewer charts across unsecure channels, you must encrypt them yourself.

1.1 Requirements

- Microsoft® Windows 2000 or Windows XP.
- 5MB hard disk space and 32MB RAM.

1.2 Installing XANALYS ChartViewer

To install ChartViewer 2.0:

- 1 Make sure you are logged on as a user who has Administrator privileges.
- 2 Quit all programs on your computer.
- 3 Double-click the downloaded .exe file.
The installer will start automatically.
- 4 Click **Install Products** and then click **XANALYS ChartViewer 2.0**.
- 5 The install wizard will start. Follow the instructions on your screen to complete the install.

1.3 Adobe Reader

To view the documentation installed with ChartViewer you will need Adobe® Reader® installed on your machine. If you do not have this software available already, you can install it from the installation disk.

To install Adobe Reader:

- 1 Make sure you are logged on as a user who has Administrator privileges.
- 2 Quit all programs on your computer.
- 3 Double-click the downloaded .exe file.
The installer will start automatically.
- 4 From the Main Menu click **Install Products > Adobe® Reader® 7.0**.
- 5 The install wizard will start. Follow the instructions on your screen to complete the install.

1.4 ChartViewer User Information

Your main sources of information about ChartViewer 2.0 are the user guide and help system that is installed with the program.

1.5 New features in this release

- ChartViewer 2.0 now displays both Link Explorer link charts and event charts.
- The chart view window is now a multiple window interface; enabling you to open more than one chart concurrently. Individual charts can be maximized, minimized or resized using Microsoft Windows commands as required.
- Charts are now exported from Link Explorer as an Xanalys Analysis Set (.xas) file. The .xas file comprises underlying data from your query, plus all the graphical information relating to the chart. Where data appears in more than one chart within ChartViewer, selection of that data or link will be reflected (selected) across all open charts
- An Explorer panel is now available. It allows you to see which charts and/or analysis sets are currently open.
- A Full Screen option is now available from the View menu.
- Either a horizontal or vertical splitter can be applied to a chart view. This feature enables you to view two areas of the same chart if required – navigating them independently.
- The About dialog (available from the Help menu) now includes information about the version of software, operating system and runtime files in use.
- New improved online Help provided. New features include drop-down hotspots using DHTML and browse sequences to ease navigation. The contents structure now mirrors the structure of the User Guide to aid familiarity.

1.6 Known issues in this release

- When printing a chart, if you select **Always show preview lines** on the **Print Setup** dialog, the screen refresh function is seriously disrupted.
- Compared to Link Explorer, the ChartViewer Print dialog has a limited choice of printing options including limited choice of paper size.
- When charts containing waypoints (see Chapter 20 of the *XANALYS Link Explorer User Guide*) are exported to ChartViewer, the waypoints will be removed.
